EASTERN STATE PENITENTIARY

Join us for the day!

We have planned a day trip to Philadelphia on <u>August 24, 2016</u> - <u>Wednesday.</u>

We will depart from Elite Coach at 8:00 a.m. and return around 7:00 p.m.

Highlights of the day include:

EASTERN STATE PENITENTIARY

Operational from 1829 until 1971 this was the first prison to focus on reform rather than punishment. When built, it was the largest & most expensive public structure. It is currently on the list of US historic landmarks. The Quaker religion influenced this new system of reflection and reform. We will take a guided tour in these semi-ruins of a model that was used for over 300 other facilities.

INDEPENDENCE PARK

Here, we have lunch in the **historic 'The Bourse'**, now serving as a large food court. This building is also on the US list of historic landmarks. There are many food & shopping options.

The Bourse means "a place of exchange" was brought to Philadelphia in 1890 by a grain & commodities exporter named George E. Bartol. It was one of the first steel framed buildings to ever be constructed.

You will then have a couple hours to see many historic sites within walking distance to include the Liberty Bell, items relating to the Constitution & Declaration of Independence. The US Mint is nearby & offers free tours. This is a do it yourself tour that lasts about 45 minutes. Or, the home of Betsy Ross can be toured for a small admission fee.

AMERICAN TREASURE TOUR

This huge, eclectic collection is housed in a facility formerly used by BF Goodrich. It contains everything from music boxes to cars, lunch boxes to doll houses.
