AGRICULTURE'S PROMISE — WASHINGTON, DC

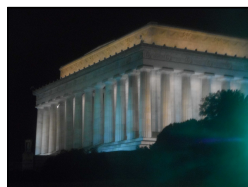

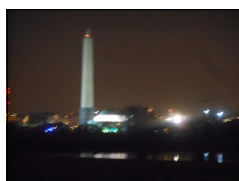
The most exciting aspects of the program are those where the participants voices are engaged. The "Talking

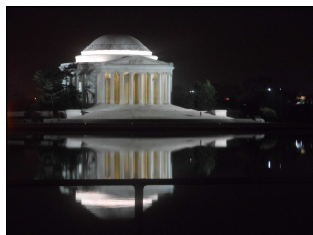
